Final Examination Schedule Notes

- Report to the same room in that the class has been scheduled. (Your instructor will notify you if the room has been changed.) Evening classes will be notified by instructor of room assignment for exam.
- Courses that meet during the day only one time per week, confirm with faculty member for exam time.
- There are no scheduled exam times for the science labs (check with your instructor).
- There are no scheduled exam times for military science courses (check with your instructor).
- Math courses with lecture and lab will have their exams according to the scheduled lecture time.
- Language courses with lecture and lab will have their exams according to the scheduled lecture time.
- ISA 201 exams may be relocated to a different room from where the class is usually scheduled (check with your instructor).
- TTR classes check with your instructor regarding final exam period.
- If a student has three final examinations on the same day, that student should make arrangements with an instructor of one of the scheduled exams to arrange an alternative examination time.
- Students may be excused for a final exam time for religious observances required by their faith. According to University policy, students must provide a written request to reschedule a final to their course instructor, the chair of the relevant department, and to the dean of the college at least 30 days prior to the start of the examination period. The rescheduled exam will typically be held within 24 hours of the originally scheduled exam.
