



Payment Plans

Students and their families have 2 payment options available to them.

OPTION I

A family may pay the semester balance in full by the following due dates:

August 9

January 9

OPTION II

A family may enroll in the Bryant University Payment Plan managed by the Bursar's Office. The benefits of in-house management allows for plan enrollment directly within the Student Account Center. The Bryant University Payment Plan offers more flexibility with 5, 4 or 3 monthly installments throughout the semester. Both students and authorized users can use the payment plan option to manage the student's account.

Payment Plan Facts:

No finance charges.

An enrollment fee of \$50 per semester is required.

Payments on the payment plan can be made by using Webcheck (ACH) or credit card.

ACH payments can only be made through a U.S. bank account.

An email notification will automatically be sent five days before the due date of the next installment payment and each time a payment is made.

You must re-enroll online each semester to use the payment plan.

There is a \$40 late fine for each payment plan installment that is not received on time.

Step 1

Calculate Estimated Semester Expenses:



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Tuition: \$24,216.00

Housing (Double): \$5,052.00

Meal Plan (210 Block): \$3,215.00

Student Involvement Fee: \$211.00

Technology Fee: \$237.50

Residence Hall Deposit: \$400.00

(applicable to new residence only)

Total Semester Expenses: \$33,331.50

Please note: It is important that enough funds are budgeted so that the bill is paid on a timely basis. Tuition and fees that are not budgeted must be paid on the said due dates under option one.

Step 2

Calculate Estimated Semester Deductions:

Grants \$4,000.00

Scholarships \$3,000.00

Direct Loan(s) \$2,722.00*

Enrollment Deposit \$800.00

Total Semester Deductions \$10,522.00

*This amount is the estimated net loan amount for a freshman recipient receiving a \$2,750.00 loan award.

Step 3

Subtract **Total Semester Deductions** from **Total Semester Expenses** to arrive at the semester payment plan amount:

Total Semester Expenses **\$33,331.50** minus

Total Semester Deductions **\$10,522.00**

Semester Payment Plan Amount \$22,809.50

Step 4



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Divide the semester payment plan amount by the plan choice (5, 4 or 3) to determine the monthly payment amount:

\$22,809.50 divided by 5 = **\$4,561.90 per month**

To enroll in the plan, simply log onto the Student Account Center and select the Enroll in Plan option.

The only cost to the family for this **interest-free** monthly payment plan option is a \$50 per semester enrollment fee.

The optional fall and spring payment plans are as follows:

Plan	# of Monthly Payments Due	Scheduled Payments
Fall Payment Plan 5	5	May 5 – Sept 5
Fall Payment Plan 4	4	June 5 – Sept 5
Fall Payment Plan 3	3	July 5 – Sept 5
Spring Payment Plan 5	5	Oct 5 – Feb 5
Spring Payment Plan 4	4	Nov 5 – Feb 5
Spring Payment Plan 3	3	Dec 5 – Feb 5



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Making an on-line payment is simple. An enrollee may also schedule their on-line payments in advance.

The use of this prepayment plan does not affect awards of financial aid. Payments under this plan must be made on a timely basis in order to avoid late fee assessments.

It is not Bryant University's policy to grant extensions for tuition payments. If families are unable to pay under option I or option II, it is recommended that they contact the Office of Financial Aid to discuss borrowing alternatives.
