



Student Fees for Study Abroad Programs 2021-2022

Study Abroad participants are charged the same rates that a traditional Bryant University student would be assessed if they were studying on campus **unless the total charge at the host institution abroad exceeds the comparable charges at Bryant University, at which time, they will also be responsible for covering the cost difference between their program and Bryant's costs.** Bryant University invoices are provided electronically via the student account center in July for the fall semester and in December for the spring semester. Bryant University's financial policies will continue to apply to students enrolled in an approved Bryant study abroad program as they are considered a Bryant University student.

Application Fees

- All other application deposits paid by Bryant.

Deposit / Confirmation Fees

- Upon acceptance the confirmation deposit will be paid by Bryant University.

Security/Refundable Deposits – Paid by Student for TEAN & API

- Students participating in a program through The Education Abroad Network (TEAN) and Academic Programs International (API) will be responsible for paying their own security deposit directly to TEAN and API. TEAN participants' deposit will be refunded, less any charges incurred during their semester abroad, at the beginning of the semester following the conclusion of their program. API participants' deposits will be refunded less the \$95 standard fee that API retains, and any other charges incurred during their semester abroad, at the beginning of the semester following the conclusion of their program.

Bryant University account, depending on the number of meals they are receiving abroad. Since the meal plan is optional in some locations, and is not typical at most institutions, additional fees do not apply to every student. Meal plan charges may not be on the initial billing statement if the university is notified, after the fact, that a meal plan has been chosen.

Study Abroad Fees

All Bryant students studying abroad will be assessed a one-time fee of \$500.00. This fee ensures that students still have access to course registration, library services, Laptop Central, Blackboard, etc.

Additional Fees

Additional fees are any supplemental costs of the program, and not billed by Bryant. These fees are estimates; they are not actual amounts and are subject to change. Such costs may include but are not limited to: Round-trip airfare, VISA processing fee, cell phones, internet usage in accommodations, gym memberships, transportation in/around, etc.

Withdrawal Policy

Bryant University disburses money to the study abroad providers when a student commits to the program and before the program abroad commences. There is a threshold date after which no funds are returned to the University for a withdrawal, which is why you are responsible for reviewing the program provider's refund policies. If a student decides to withdraw from the program abroad, after they have committed to the program, the student is responsible for any non-refundable costs from the program provider. Furthermore, if a student leaves a program, whether voluntarily or not, he/she should not expect refunds for any unrecoverable costs; leaving a program may include, but is not limited to, these reasons: academic dismissal, student conduct violations, civil unrest, epidemics/pandemics, and natural disasters.
